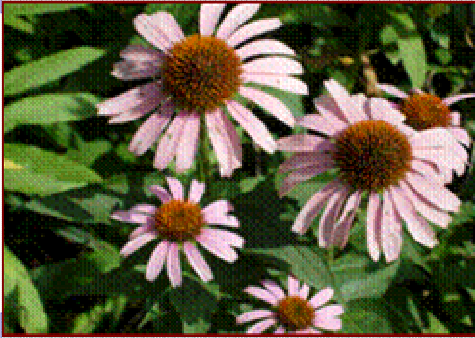

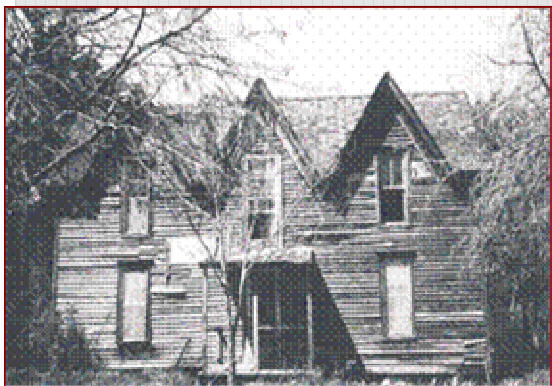

Historic sites abound in North Texas. Collin County has a wealth of museums, heritage properties, Victorian-era homes, courthouses and pioneer cemeteries.

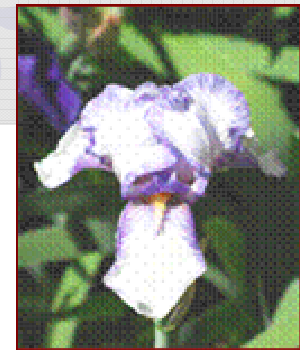
